FLECE ENTRY FEE: \$12 per entry, plus \$3 ALSA fee (ALSA fee waived if llama is entered in youth, performance or halter classes).

WALKING FLEECE ENTRY FEE: \$15 per entry, plus \$3 ALSA fee (ALSA fee waived if llama is entered in youth, performance or halter classes).

<u>NEW!</u> Flat Rate Option for All Open Halter, Performance, Fleece and Specialty Classes! \$50 per llama entry — enter as many classes as you like for each llama entered! Or, if you prefer, pay \$15 per class per llama including walking fleece, \$12 per class for shorn fleece (note: halter is two shows, automatically \$30/llama).

TIMES: Refer to the Llama Show time schedule.

SHOW RULES: See the ALSA Handbook - 16th Edition. Entry tags and display bags will be provided at check-in. Be prepared to supply your ALSA # and (for shorn fleece and walking fleece entries) your llama's ALSA #, along with a copy of your llama's ILR form.

MAIL-IN ENTRIES: You may also UPS fleece entries, to arrive by June 4, 2012 to: The Fairgrounds at Stanley Park, Attn: Llama Fleece Show, 1209 Manford Ave., Estes Park, CO 80517. Include return postage and address label if you want your entry returned after the show. See special mailing instructions for Hand Spinner's Choice class below.

<u>RIBBONS:</u> First through sixth place; Grand and Reserve for Shorn and Walking Fleece.

<u>CLASS DESCRIPTIONS:</u> See ALSA Handbook – 16th Edition for details, or contact show superintendent for more details.

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- L26 Walking Fleece: Fleece will be judged on the llama, by appointment on Saturday, June 9th. Appointments and judging location to be made at check-in and Saturday exhibitor meeting. Judge will determine double, single and suri coat divisions during judging.
- LF1 Shorn Fleece: Your entry may consist of an entire shorn fleece, but must include at least the barrel section minus skirting.
- LF2 Open Felted: The entry must be felted by the exhibitor only. The fiber used must be at least 75 percent llama.
- LF3 Open Hand Knit and/or Crochet, Hand Spun by exhibitor: The entry must be knitted and/or crocheted by the exhibitor only. All the yarn must be hand spun and be at least 75 percent llama. Hand knitting only. Machine knitting will not be accepted. No commercial yarns.
- LF4 Open Hand Knit and/or Crochet using commercial yarns: The entry must be knitted and/or crocheted by the exhibitor only. Yarn must be at least 75 percent llama yarn. However, all the yarn need not be spun by the exhibitor. Hand knitting only. Machine knitting will not be accepted.
- _F5 Open Hand Spinner's Choice.
- NOTE: This is a 2 oz. sample of prime fiber from the blanket area. Fiber may be sheared or brushed; guard hair and debris must be removed. The judge will prepare a portion by carding, and another by combing, and spin the samples. Fiber must be 100 percent llama from an animal owned by the exhibitor. The sample must be at the Fairgrounds by 6 p.m. Friday, June 8th.
- LF6 Open Hand Spun Yarn: The entry must be hand spun by the exhibitor only and be comprised of at least 75 percent llama fiber.
