

Camping: A camping area with water & electricity is available at the facility. Rates are \$25.00 per night & must be prepaid on your entry form. **You must secure a camping permit at the show Office.**

Triple Ring Show: Three rings will be running simultaneously using the following procedures.

⇒The halter class ring will be run in the published sequence.

⇒Halter classes have priority.

⇒Two classes will be run simultaneously in the performance ring. Each class will be held open until all of the entrants have completed the course. Please plan your performance schedule to assure that you do not miss a halter class. The classes will be announced to assure no one misses a class.

Halter Classes: Each Llama must be entered in its appropriate age and wool division at the time of the Grand National, regardless of the age or wool division in which it initially qualified. On a Llama's date of birth, the Llama moves up to the older class. All four wool divisions will be included in the Grand National. If you qualified at a show where wool divisions were combined (e.g., Light/Medium or Medium/Heavy), you must choose the correct wool division for the Grand National.

Pack Classes: It has come to our attention that Llama exhibitors are using small packs intended for alpacas. At the Grand National, it is expected that pack systems will be of proper scale for the animal's size.

Produce-of-Dam and Get-of-Sire: Please make your entry in the Dam or Sire's name on you entry Form and send a copy of their ILR Certificate. You must fill out and include a copy of the enclosed Produce/Get sheet with your entry. In accordance with handbook changes for 2007, all Get of Sire and Produce of Dam entries must be Champions or have qualified by placing first in a class with a minimum of 3 entries shown at an ALSA show during the current ALSA year. any other offspring from the same sire or dam may be shown provided the offspring has been shown at an ALSA Show during the current year.

Deadlines: Everyone is encourage to enter as early as possible, due to the time restraints on getting the information to the publisher. The deadline for entries to be included in the showbook will be October 14, 2008. Show Clerk must have **ALL** entries by **OCTOBER 14, 2008 @ 9 am (CST)**. If not received by this time, your entries may not be listed in the showbook.

Banners: Please bring your farm banners so that we may hang them in the arena.
